


# Français I

**The focus of the French program is learning to use the language.**


Our text series is Bien Dit. We focus on speaking, listening comprehension, reading, writing and culture. Student progress will be assessed frequently through quizzes, tests, classwork, homework, projects and oral presentations.



- Students will have a “real world” homework sheet to complete during each unit.
- A certain number of activities on the real world sheet must be completed in order to get 100% for a homework grade.
- If a student completes fewer than the required number of activities by the end of the unit, the homework grade will be adjusted accordingly.
- If a student has 100% for homework for the completed units in a six weeks, the lowest quiz or classwork grade will be dropped.

### Classroom procedures

I expect students to be in class on time and to participate fully. You should take the time between classes to go to the bathroom, get a drink, go to your lockers, etc. You will receive a pass at the beginning of the semester which may be used 5 times for trips out of the



classroom to bathroom, locker, etc. If you use all 5 spaces on the pass, trips outside the classroom will be counted as unexcused tardies. This pass is to last for the entire semester. Lost passes will not be replaced. You must always get permission from the teacher to leave the
