9. Do not attach stickers, magnets, photos, etc. to any hardware.
10. Do not remove county property identification numbers from hardware.

- 1st Time: Verbal Warning
- 2nd Time: Loss of Participation Points
- 3rd Time: Parent Contact
- 4th Time: Referral to Administration
