All Seniors Applying for Scholarships

Remember to complete a Transcript Request Form for EACH scholarship you are applying for. This form can be found in the guidance office and is green, or you can access it online from the WMHS website, under Counseling, Documents/Forms (direct link is at <http://www.augusta.k12.va.us/cms/lib01/VA01000173/Centricity/Domain/771/Transcript%20Request%20Form.pdf>). It is the same one used for college applications. On it is important information we need regarding what YOU want for the scholarship application including deadlines, letters desired, etc. Even if the application is completed online, please fill a form out so that we are aware of what is needed and when. As with college applications, we ask for a MINIMUM of a 5 day turnaround for these to be processed. These forms should be turned in to Mrs. Landes in the Guidance Office.

Portal Access for Seeing Student Grades

Want to be more informed about your student's progress? Not too late for portal access! Parents/Guardians who are not currently accessing this great tool and would like to be, please contact your student's counselor. In order to have portal access, each student must have on file the Student Verification form with a current email address for each parent/guardian who wants to be able to view the portal. These forms were sent home to be signed at the beginning of the year. If you do not have one on file, another copy may be issued to be confirmed and signed. Once this is on file, instructions to access the portal will be emailed to the address(es) listed on the Student Verification form. In addition to accessing your student's progress and grades, you also have the ability to review 2015-2016 Course Requests. Questions about courses – please see your student's School Counselor.
