Employee Health Screening

1. Have you had a temperature greater than 100.4 in the last 24 hours?
2. Have you had a new cough, shortness of breath, changes in taste or smell, chills, sore throat, diarrhea, and/or nausea, fatigue (more tired than usual), headache, muscle aches, nasal congestion that is different than usual in the last 24 hours?
3. Have you taken medication to lower your temperature in the past 24 hours?
4. Have you been in close contact (less than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes with or without a face covering) with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 and have not yet completed the full 14 days of quarantine?
5. Have you been in close contact (less than 6 feet for more than 15 minutes with or without a face covering) with anyone who is currently awaiting COVID-19 test results?
6. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 and have not yet completed the full 10 days of isolation?

If you answered **YES** to any of these questions, please stay home. Contact your health care provider or the health department immediately, and contact your principal/supervisor as quickly as possible. If you've received direction regarding a quarantine/isolation, please follow the timelines provided.

If you are presently at work and answer **YES** to any of these questions, contact your supervisor immediately and leave work. Contact your health care provider or the health department for direction as quickly as possible.

Local public health authorities determine and establish the quarantine options for their jurisdictions. CDC currently recommends a quarantine period of 14 days. Options to shorten quarantine with acceptable alternatives were provided by the CDC on December 2, 2020. Augusta County Public Schools with the assistance of the Virginia Department of Health will continue to follow the recommended quarantine period of 14 days.
