

Stuarts Draft High School Parking Permit Application And Regulations

Augusta County provides public transportation to students at no expense to the student. Therefore, students who are permitted to drive personal automobiles to school are to consider it a privilege, not a guaranteed right. Any violation of the regulations listed below may result in the withdrawal of driving privileges since your safety and the safety of others is dependent upon following all of the safety precautions.

- Parking tags will initially be issued to seniors & juniors followed by sophomores if additional spots are available
- Driving license (regular or ninety-day license) and this application must be presented with the \$50.00 fee in order to receive a parking tag. A replacement cost for a lost or stolen tag is \$50.00. A parking tag for second semester only will be pro-rated at a cost of \$25.00. There will be no other price adjustments.
- Selling or receiving a parking tag illegally will result in the loss of the current and possibly future driving privileges for both parties involved.
- All vehicles parked on school grounds must have a valid parking pass. The parking tag is to be displayed clearly on the front mirror at all times. Vehicles without a proper tag are subject to being towed at the owner's expense. Parking at Stuarts Draft Middle School or Elementary school are prohibited.
- Once entering the parking lot, drivers are to park their vehicle and they and their riders are to enter the school and not be hanging out in the parking lot.
- Skipping school, leaving school without permission, and/or excessive tardiness will result in a loss of driving privileges for an extended period of time.
- The vehicle must be maintained and operated in a safe manner at all times. Unsafe, reckless driving, or speeding could result in suspension of the parking permit.
- School bus traffic will always have the right of way at all times on school property. If a bus is stopped, loading, or unloading you must stop for the bus.
- **Car trouble, traffic, and any other driving related excuses for being tardy will not be accepted, and will count as an unexcused tardy.**
- Request for emergency permission to drive must be submitted to an administrator before driving to school.
