Scholarship Information

What is this award?

It is a scholarship supported by funds raised by members of the ACEA to help ensure continued quality education in this county.

What is the amount of the scholarship?

\$500.00 for one school year for 2 high school students, who plan to major in the education field.

What will the winner receive and how will the award be made?

The scholarship recipients will be formally announced and presented a certificate at the annual ACEA/ACSB Spring Banquet. The winners receive a \$500.00 check immediately after notifying the ACEA treasurer in writing that he/she has enrolled full time for the fall term in a formal post secondary course of study in education. A check will then be sent directly to the recipient and/or high school where the winner is currently enrolled and will be notified by the end of May.

How does one apply?

1. *The attached application must be completed.*
2. *Three letters of recommendation as described on the application must be submitted with the completed application.*
3. *All applications and references must be submitted to the **school guidance coordinator by Monday March 15, 2019.***
